NARRATIVE

About 8:45 PM on Saturday, February 15th, 2020, Officers Ryther and Sullivan-Venezia in the G201F responded to a radio call for an Assault & Battery at the intersection of Maverick Square and Chelsea Street in East Boston.

On arrival officers observed several individuals on the sidewalk at the aforementioned intersection. Officers immediately separated the apparent opposing parties within the group. Officers spoke with [redacted] and her daughter, [redacted]. Both [redacted] and [redacted] stated that they were speaking with each other in Spanish when they were approached by two white females (later identified as [redacted] and [redacted]). [redacted] and [redacted] informed officers that they believe [redacted] and [redacted] thought they were making fun of them due to the fact that [redacted] and [redacted] could not understand Spanish. [redacted] and [redacted] stated [redacted] and [redacted] began shouting at them and that [redacted] then began physically attacking them. [redacted] stated that [redacted] scratched the left side of her face and bit her right thumb. Officers observed a large scratch on [redacted]'s left cheek as well as a small laceration to her right thumb. [redacted] stated that [redacted] then pulled her hair and punched her in the face multiple times with closed fists. Both [redacted] and [redacted] denied the need for medical attention.

Officers spoke with [redacted] and [redacted], who stated that they witnessed the altercation. [redacted] and [redacted] stated that they observed [redacted] and [redacted] approach [redacted] and [redacted] unprovoked and begin loudly shouting at them. [redacted] and [redacted] further stated that they then observed [redacted] physically attack both [redacted] and [redacted]. At this point [redacted] and [redacted] intervened by separating [redacted] from [redacted] and [redacted]. [redacted] stated that, while separating these parties, [redacted] was punched in the face with a closed fist three times by [redacted]. [redacted] denied injury and refused medical attention.

Officers then spoke with [redacted] and [redacted], who stated that, while walking in the area of Maverick Square, they heard [redacted] and [redacted] laughing and speaking in Spanish. Believing that the two were making fun of them, [redacted] and [redacted] engaged in a verbal argument with [redacted] and [redacted]. [redacted] and [redacted] stated that the verbal altercation became physical when [redacted] punched [redacted] in the face with a closed fist. [redacted] stated that she then defended herself by fighting back. Officers observed multiple small scratches on [redacted]'s face and a small amount of blood around her fingernails. [redacted] refused the need for medical attention. It should be noted that [redacted] and [redacted] admitted that they had been drinking and acting belligerent.
